

Eligibility

To receive benefits under the yellow ribbon program, a student:

- Must have served an aggregate period of 36 months on active duty after Sept. 10, 2001, **or**
- Received a Purple Heart after Sept. 10, 2001, and honorably discharged after any amount of service, **or**
- Have served 30 continuous days after Sept. 10, 2001, and honorably discharged from active duty with a service-connected disability, **or**
- Recipient of the Marine Gunnery Sergeant John David Fry Scholarship after August 1, 2018, **or**
- Be a dependent eligible for Transfer of Entitlement who qualifies at the 100% level under the Post-9/11 GI Bill.

Students receiving an out-of-state fee waiver due to Section 702 of the Veterans Access, Choice and Accountability Act of 2014 are not eligible for the Yellow Ribbon program.

Required Information

Requests for the Yellow Ribbon program will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. There are a limited number of awards. The University of Florida will contribute a maximum of \$6500 per academic year toward the out-of-state fees not covered by the Post-9/11 GI Bill. The VA will match the amount contributed by the university not to exceed the total amount of out-of-state charges. Students must be using their Post-9/11 entitlement. Students will remain in the program provided they maintain continuous enrollment and satisfactory progress toward their degree goal.
